2015 delivering 13 new 2016 model year Millennium Luxury Coaches with innovative design and custom features not seen before. Our customers are an integral part of the design of our custom coaches. Industry changing progress was made in our new floor plan designs. We added three new floor plans including one for the X3. For the H3 we created a floor plan that offers the owner the best of everything including a quad slide, private shower, larger main vanity sink, and stateroom super slides. Wait until you see the new line of wood veneers allowing us the ability to offer 4 distinct finishes from gloss, semi-gloss, satin or flat! 2015 saw us build two quad slides with flat floors. We engineered a way to increase the walkway and the slides are able to reduce the overall weight of the coach by 1,000 pounds. This was liked so well we will be building a few more flat floors in 2016.

Innovation and customer service lead the Millennium culture. Starting with the

2017 model the Tyron tire protection system will be standard on all quad slides. Other standard features include a rain sensor that automatically retracts the awnings when the rain starts and a state of the art cockpit sound system along with the latest LED lighting technology.

We continue to add qualified personnel to the service team with better training, processes and procedures.

Please take a minute to read the meet the cast section where you will meet Scott Puch, Millennium's Service department Manager. He has been instrumental along with Willie and Steve in shaping the Millennium service department to be one of the best in our industry.



personalize their own private docks. Captain Hank, the popular resident guide, regularly leads parties down and optional beachfront picnics.



## EGGNOG HOT CHOCOLATE

#### Ingredients:

2 ½ cups milk

12 ounces bittersweet chocolate chips

4 cups eggnog

1 tsp vanilla extract

1/4 cup coffee flavored liqueur, Kahlua (optional)

Whipped cream (optional)

8 cinnamon sticks, garnish (optional)

**Directions:** In a medium saucepan, melt chocolate in milk over medium-low heat. Remove from heat, and let stand for 2 minutes. Whisk the chocolate until melted and smooth. Stir in the eggnog, and heat gently over low heat until very warm but not boiling. Remove from heat, and stir in the vanilla and coffee liqueur. Pour into mugs, and serve with whipped cream and a cinnamon stick garnish.



## BREAKFAST PIZZA

#### Ingredients:

Cooking spray

- 1 pound bacon, chopped
- 2 (12 ounce) cans refrigerated biscuits (10 biscuits per can)
- 1 tsp butter
- 12 eggs
- 1 small onion, chopped
- ½ green bell pepper, chopped
- 2 cups shredded cheddar cheese
- Salt and pepper to taste

**Directions:**Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Lightly spray a 9x12 inch backing sheet with cooking spray. Cook the bacon in a large skillet over medium heat, stirring often, until the bacon is browned and crisp, about 10 minutes. Remove bacon pieces with a slotted spoon, and drain on paper towels. Open up the cans of biscuits, separate the biscuits, and arrange onto the prepared baking sheet so they touch. Press the biscuit dough down to seal them together into a crust that covers the baking sheet. Bake in the preheated oven until the crust is slightly cooked and very lightly browned, about 5 minutes. Do not overbake. Remove from the oven. Melt the butter in a large nonstick skillet over medium heat until the foam disappears. Beat the eggs in a bowl, and pour the eggs into the hot skillet. Use the spatula to lift and gently stir the eggs just until set, but still moist, 3 to 4 minutes. Arrange the lightly scrambled eggs on the semi-baked biscuit crust. Top with the cooked bacon, onion and green pepper; spread the cheddar cheese all over the pizza. Season to taste with salt and black pepper. Return to oven, and bake on the top rack until the cheese is melted and bubbling and has begun to brown, about 10 more minutes. This recipe can be very versatile depending on your preferences, like cracking an egg on top instead of scrambling.

## BAKED COCONUT FRENCH TOAST

#### Ingredients:

Cooking spray

- 16 (1 inch thick) slices French bread, cut diagonally
- 1 1/4 cups light coconut milk
- 1 1/4 cups egg substitute
- ½ cup white sugar
- 1 tbs vanilla extract
- 1 ½ cup sweetened flaked coconut

#### Directions:

Spray the inside of the 9x13 inch baking dish with cooking spray. Arrange bread slices in a single layer in the prepared baking dish. Whisk coconut milk, egg substitute, sugar and vanilla extract together in a bowl until evenly combined; pour over bread. Turn bread over to coat. Cover baking dish



with plastic wrap and refrigerate, 8 hours to overnight. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Remove plastic wrap from dish. Turn bread slices over and sprinkle coconut over bread; let stand for 15 minutes. Bake in the preheated oven until egg is set and coconut is golden, about 30 minutes.
